

How to... build your own hanging garden

Materials

1x timber pallet

Steps

- With a pinch bar, carefully remove all of the top battens, leaving the bottom one as a base. Leave the back boards as they are.
- Remove all the rusty nails.
- Re-space the boards to allow for several large gaps so the plants can see the sunlight. I've used gaps of 200mm.
- Use stainless steel screws to fix the board in place.
- Hammer in pieces of off-cut timber, cut to length to hold the soil. You can also staple in weed mat or shade cloth to really secure your topsoil in place.
- Secure to your fence and get planting
